What is Tribal Online Gaming?

- It is gaming (Social and Money) that is conducted on Indian Lands
- Regulated by Tribes in full compliance under IGRA
- It may or may not involve play over the Internet
- It involves using an online platform located on Indian Land
- It is for games conducted on Indian Land
- Supports Skill-based Gaming
- eSports
- Class II Games

Regulatory Compliance

- The Tribal Online Gaming Platform must be fully compliant with NIGC Regulations §543 & §547,
- It must be fully compliant with the Unlawful Internet Gaming Enforcement Act (“UIGEA”), and
- Most importantly fully compliant with TGRA regulations and Tribal Laws

Compliance – Must have components

- Full KYC Registration
- State of art Geo-Fencing & Security
- Integrated
 - *Record keeping for Accounts (User Profile with -KYC & Geo-Fencing data)*
 - *Banking & Account management with full audit and reporting*
 - Accounting, Title 31, IRS & OFAC
 - Full suite of analytical reports
 - *Encrypted and redundant security with disaster recovery*
 - *Responsible Gaming oversight & reporting*
- CMS/CRM with promotions and loyalty

Why is Online Tribal Gaming Important?

- The overriding objective is to give Indian Gaming the place it deserves in every discussion or proposal in the expanding world of online gaming
- The system described can be fully **Class II** giving Tribes the maximum flexibility to shape the future
- This type of system also helps provide the leverage and economic potential to, if necessary, demand fair treatment by those that may see Indian Gaming as an after-thought in the online gaming market
